



Percentile Ranks help us compare a student's performance to others in a norm group. A percentile rank of 53, for example, means that the student scored equal to or above 53% of students of that grade or age in the norm group.

Scores between the 25th percentile and the 75th percentile can be considered within the normal range. 50% of students in the norm group scored within this range.
